During our Classroom Morning Sing-a-Ding the classes will focus on our philosophy and encourage your wonderful children to embrace themselves & to be the best person they can be! Throughout the year we will talk about... Practicing good manners, Respect, Friendship, Kindness and Generosity.

"Thinking of Others" by Donating to the Food Bank

Our curriculum is set up to encourage your children to love school and experience all the joy that comes with learning new things. We also offer opportunities to experience the true pleasure that comes with helping those in need and putting others first. This year we will continue our program entitled: 'Gertie Gives' (this will run throughout the school year). Starting in September we will collect food on a daily basis for a local food bank. During Classroom Sing-a-Ding the teachers will explain how a food bank works. The teachers will suggest that the Giving Nest students, when shopping with their families, ask if they can pick out something to put in the food bank. Things in need are canned goods; such as sauces, vegetables and tuna. Peanut butter is in big demand as well as pasta products and dry cereal. There is also a need for deodorant, toothpaste, toilet paper, hand crème, and disposable diapers. However, anything your child wishes to donate will be appreciated. We will deliver the items we collect each week to The North Plainfield Food Bank.

Each morning the teacher will ask if anyone has food for the food bank. Those children will be invited to come up to the front of the room, put their donation on the table and to form a line. The children will all sing our donation song and they will clap and say "Thank You" to the donators of the day!

Canopy Tent Location for Classes H, I, & J
Date: 9/8/21 Rain Date – 9/9/21

Location of Your Canopy Tent: As you pull into our parking lot, please park in the spaces in front of the church and in the front of our school building. Your canopy tent will be the first tent as you pull into the parking lot. It will be labeled: Classes H, I, & J. You and your child will go over to the tent to meet his/her teachers! Please wear a Face Mask!

Time Schedule for Class H is from 10:00 to 10:20 Time Schedule for Class I is from 10:30 to 10:50 Time Schedule for Class J is from 11:00 to 11:20

Canopy Tent Location for Classes A/A+, B, C, E-1, D-1/D-2/E-2/F Date: 9/8/21 Rain Date – 9/9/21

Location of Your Canopy Tent: As you pull into our parking lot, please park in the spaces across from the orange cones. Your canopy tent will be the second tent as you pull into the parking lot. It will be labeled: Classes A/A+, B, C, E-1, & D-1/D-2/E-2/F. You and your child will go over to the tent to meet his/her teachers! Please wear a Face Mask!

Time Schedule for Class A/A+ is from 9:30 to 9:50
Time Schedule for Class B is from 10:00 to 10:20
Time Schedule for Class C is from 10:30 to 10:50
Time Schedule for Class E-1 is from 11:00 to 11:20
Time Schedule for Class D-1, D-2, E-2 & F is from 11:30 to 11:50

Canopy Tent Location for Classes G, K/L & M
Date: 9/8/21 Rain Date – 9/9/21

Location of Your Canopy Tent: As you pull into our parking lot, please park in the spaces on the side of our school building. Your canopy tent will be on the grassy area by our single entrance door in the back of our building. It will be labeled: Classes G, K/L & M. You and your child will go over to the tent to meet his/her teachers! Please wear a Face Mask!

Time Schedule for Class G is from 10:00 to 10:20 Time Schedule for Class K/L is from 10:30 to 10:50 Time Schedule for Class M is from 11:30 to 11:50

Things your Child needs for school...

(This information was in our Admissions Packet but we thought it would be helpful to put it in the newsletter) Below are the required items that your child will need for September. These items have been thoughtfully selected to keep your child safe, organized and comfortable throughout their time at The Giving Nest.

1. Backpack: It is important that the backpack is large (size 12"wide, 15" tall and 5" deep) because we need it to hold all of your child's belongings. It will be used as a 'cubby' to keep your child's things all in one place. Please put your child's first name in bold print on the outside of the backpack.

2. Small Reusable Water Bottle: All children will need a reusable water bottle. This bottle will go to and from school – Please Label the Bottle (Lid and Bottle) with Your Child's First and Last Name in PERMANENT MARKER and please don't forget to fill it with fresh water each time your child comes to school.



3. Face Covering: All children (ages 3 and over), staff and drop off and/or pick-up person must wear a Face Mask during arrival and dismissal time. All face coverings MUST BE labeled with your child's first name. These items should be placed inside an individual ziplock baggies and the baggies MUST BE labeled with your child's first and last name.

4. Snack Time: ALL CHILDREN should bring a 'small snack' every time they come to school. The snack should be in a baggie or a container that is labeled "Snack" and please put do not put it in your child's lunch box (maybe put in the front zipper part of the backpack). Some ideas: Goldfish, Cheese and Crackers, Pirate Bootie, Veggie Sticks, Cut Up Fruits or Vegetables, Graham Crackers, or a Granola Bar.

5. **Lunch:** All children will have lunch while at school. Please clearly label the outside of your child's lunchbox with your child's first name. Food cannot be refrigerated or heated and any food that has been opened cannot be returned home at this time.

6. Change of Clothes: All children should have a complete change of clothes (include underwear and socks) in their backpack. Please put them in a labeled plastic bag. We will use these in the case of a bathroom accident or a food/drink spill. Don't forget to change the choice of clothes as the seasons change.

7. Two Current Photos of your Child: Please send in two current photos of your child. The pictures are used so the students can help the teacher with attendance and small groups. Please put your child's full name on the back of the pictures. Please bring the pictures on the first day of school. Chick-a-dee & Ducklings Classes Only...

1. Diapers & Wipes – Chick-a-dees & Ducklings Only: If your child is in diapers, you will need to put in at least three diapers and wipes in a sealed plastic bag that is labeled with your child's first and last name. Please do not send in PULL-UP'S UNLESS THEY HAVE VELCRO.


2. Two Beach or Over Sized Bath Towels: Children that attend our full day Chick-a-dee class or our full day Duckling classes will need two beach or over-sized bath towels that will be used for quiet rest time (one to put on the mat & one to use as a cover). Please put these items in a nylon bag with a drawstring and print your child's name on both towels and the bag. Children will bring their towels home at the end of each school day. These towels need to be laundered before they can be used again.
