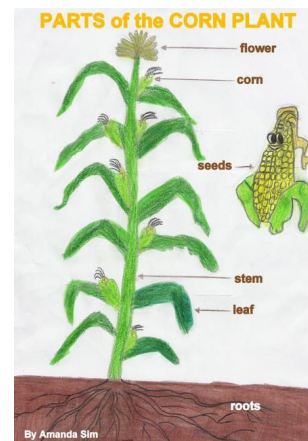

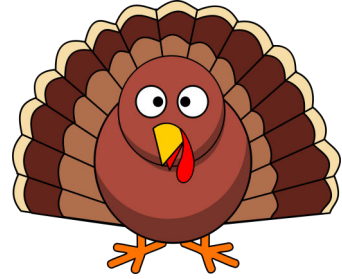

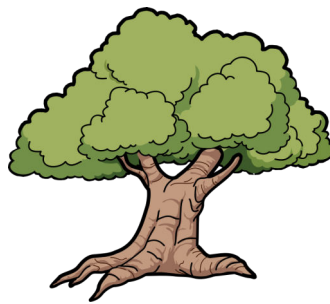


THE SQUIRREL SONG
