All information is being distributed via email. If you do not receive the Summer Camp Information email by the end of February, please see Tracy asap!

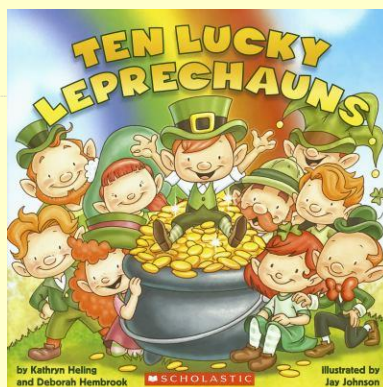
Registration is on a first come first serve basis.

I will give you my pot of gold!

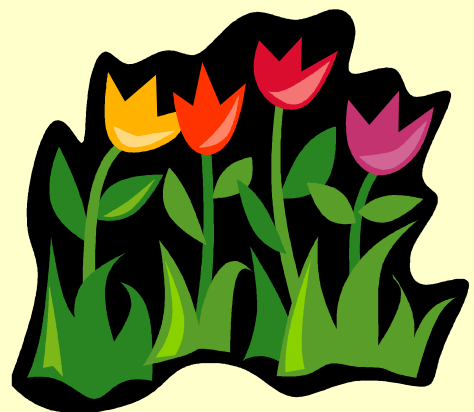


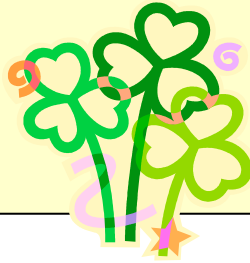
Go On a Leprechaun Hunt!

Next a rain cloud comes and waters all around.

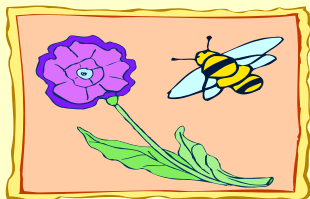
Next the sun shines brightly, without a single sound.
