Colors of the Month:


We will be focusing on these colors:

Shape of the Month: Circle

Story of the Month

Stone Soup



Stone Soup is a wonderful interactive story that teaches cooperation and sharing. The teacher will tell the story using our flannel board figures and afterwards the children will act out the story. The teacher will put a big soup pot and spoon in the middle of the circle and each child will be given a "vegetable". As the teacher retells the story she will name a vegetable and the child holding that vegetable will put it in the pot and stir the soup. The story will continue until all the children have had a turn adding their ingredient to the soup.

Good Manners

The teacher will give each child an index card that has a statement of a child using good manners or a child using not so good manners. The teacher will read the statement and the child will decide if the statement shows good or bad manners.





Fire Safety

The children will...

- Learn 911 and STOP, DROP, and ROLL and COVER YOUR FACE
 - The children will pretend to be firefighters!
- The children will discuss and practice going to a meeting place if the house is on fire



Using Scissors and Cutting Pieces of Sturdy Paper

One of our main goals this year is to instruct the children in the correct

manner of cutting with scissors. We do this in a series of steps. Our first step is to give the children safety scissors and have them cut in the air, instructing them on the proper way to hold the scissor. The children will then cut up colored construction paper and index cards (the sturdy paper is easier for them to cut) and paste it to another paper. This way they can practice their colors, cutting, and gluing skills all at the same time.
