# November Science Experiments...



1. Experiment: "Bottled Up"

Hypothesis: What will happen to the water in a plastic bottle when it is punctured with a push pin?

Answer: As long as the bottle is sealed at the top the forces will remain equal and the water will not leak out the pinhole.

### 2. Experiment: "Celery Surprise"

Hypothesis: What will happen to a stalk of celery when it is placed in a glass of colored water?"

Answer: The children will be able to see how the water travels up the stalk of celery to the leaves. You can see the tubes the colored water travels through to reach the leaves.
