Letter L: L is for Llama ... l is for lamp

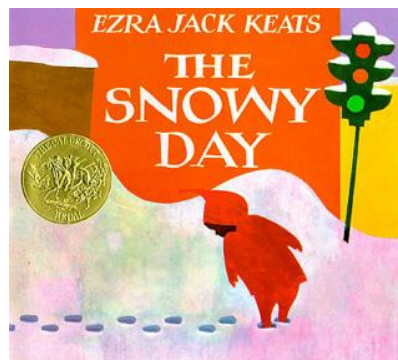
Letter K: K is for Koala Bear ... k is for kangaroo!

Scientist of the Month

Antonie van Leeuwenhoek



Antonie van Leeuwenhoek was a Dutch scientist who is considered the "Father of Microbiology". He designed his own microscopes and was able to use them to observe microscopic organisms including muscle fibers, bacteria, and red blood cells. The children will learn all about him and perform fun and interesting experiments based on his contributions to the science world.
