March Science Experiment...



1.Experiment: "Static Electricity" –

1. The children will see what happens when you hang two balloons next to each other after they have been rubbed to have an electrical charge. Will they go together, pull apart, or will the balloons pop?
 - a. They will go together
2. The children will discover what happens when you rub a balloon on your hair or on a sweater. Will the balloon move around, stay still or will it pop?
 - a. Move around
