December Science Experiments...




1. Experiment: "Tipsy"

Hypothesis: What will happen when a glass filled with water has a piece of cardboard slid over the top and is then tipped over?

Answer: The cardboard will stay in place because of air pressure pushing up from the outside. This pressure is greater than the weight of the water pushing down on the cardboard from the outside. .




"BIG" Word of the Week...
