Halloween Celebrations and Parades

Halloween is always a fun and festive time at the Giving Nest. To continue to make this holiday a fun filled day for the children and parents, while keeping everyone safe, we will be having individual Halloween Parades for each class. You (no more than 3 people) are invited to come and enjoy the children dressed in costumes. Your child's date and time will be on their class calendars. We will also send an email with parade specifics in the beginning of October.

Our Ducklings will parade and then they will perform spooky songs and poems. The Kindergarteners, Bluebirds and Cardinals will show off their costumes in a fashion show and sing Halloween songs. Each parade will last approximately 20 minutes.

The festivities will take place outside in the lower parking lot in a marked area if weather permits. If the weather does not cooperate, we will have the Halloween Parades and Fashion Shows in the classrooms, sorry no parents allowed inside.

The children should come to school dressed in costume on the day of the parade. (If the costume is uncomfortable, please have clothes underneath or send in a change of clothes he/she can change into).

Each class will also celebrate with a Halloween Party. If you would like to contribute to the festivities, we will be emailing sign-ups, using Sign-Up Genius, for Halloween goodies to share with the class. All items on the list are prepackaged items, no homemade items are permitted at this time. Please note, parties are for the children only.



Learning about Fire Safety

During morning Circle Time, we will talk about fire safety through lessons and stories. We will learn the steps to take if the children smell smoke or see a fire, calling 911, stop-drop-roll and cover your faces and planning a meeting place. We are looking for to invite a fire truck to visit the Giving Nest, the children in each class would each get a turn to walk outside and tour the fire truck and ask questions to the Firefighters. The firefighters will also describe the equipment a firefighter wears, explaining each piece of apparatus. How exciting it will be for the children to learn about these especially important lifesaving skills. If you know of any firehouse that would like to stop by for the children, please let us know.

Please get your Flu Shot

Influenza Vaccine: Children 6 months through 59 months attending any childcare or preschool facility must annually receive at least one dose of influenza vaccine between September 1 & December 31 each year. It is very important you comply with this state mandate. The state sends a nurse to the Giving Nest and all preschools to check each child's medical paperwork and ascertain all shots have been administered. If shots are not up to date the child may have to leave the school. The state nurse checks all immunizations. BLACK CAT


Black cat, black cat, looking for a witch.
