## In March Our Scientist of the Month Will Be Your Child!

All month the children will be learning about the 5 senses. We will perform different experiments and determine which sense will help us to reach a

conclusion. For example, before class the teacher will pour salt into Jar #1 and sugar into jar#2. First our little scientists will shake the jars and listen to see if the sense of *hearing* will let them know which is which, next they will use the sense of *touch* to feel the contents in the two jars, then use the sense of *sight* and look at the two jars and then use the sense of *smell* to smell the items. Finally using the sense of *taste* they will make a guess as to which



is salt and which is sugar. Children will then be asked what sense helped them the most.

The children will also participate in a 5 senses/differently abled workshop. We will be asking for 5 parent volunteers to help with this. The children will visit five stations exploring the five senses and also will learn to appreciate and accept children and adults who are differently abled. They will decorate a sun, print the word and then use cheerios to write the word in Braille, they will taste things and determined if they were sweet, bitter, salty etc. and they played basketball in a wheelchair to understand that children with handicaps can do many of the things they can do; they just do it differently.
