YOUR TERRIFIC TODDLER!

Cognitive Development: Toddlers are busy exploring and constructing an understanding of the world. They are fascinated by words and are learning to repeat the words and phrases that they hear. As toddler educators, we will encourage language development this month by singing or saying all our wonderful Halloween songs and poems.

Physical Development: Toddlers thrive in an environment that allows them to move freely and feel comfortable in their growing bodies. They need opportunities each day to practice emerging coordination, movement, and balance skills. They also develop their fine motor skills using their hands and fingers to interact with their environment. We will encourage physical development this month by dancing on tiptoes, walking on a "tightrope" (a strip of tape adhered to the floor), jumping like frogs, playing with large soft balls, and playing with nesting toys.

Creative Art Development: Art gives toddlers opportunities to explore the functions of various materials. They are discovering the sensation of making marks on paper, touching play dough, and interacting with paint. Exploration is not about a result, but rather creating and observing effects. We will encourage creative art development this month by making fall & Halloween projects!

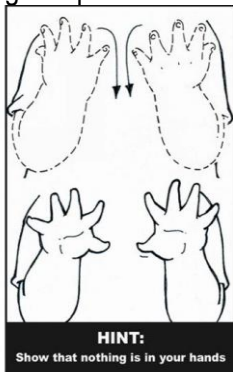

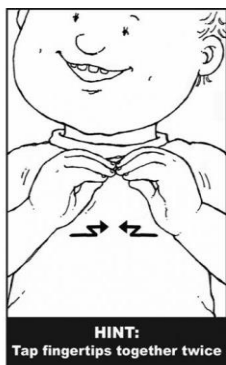
